

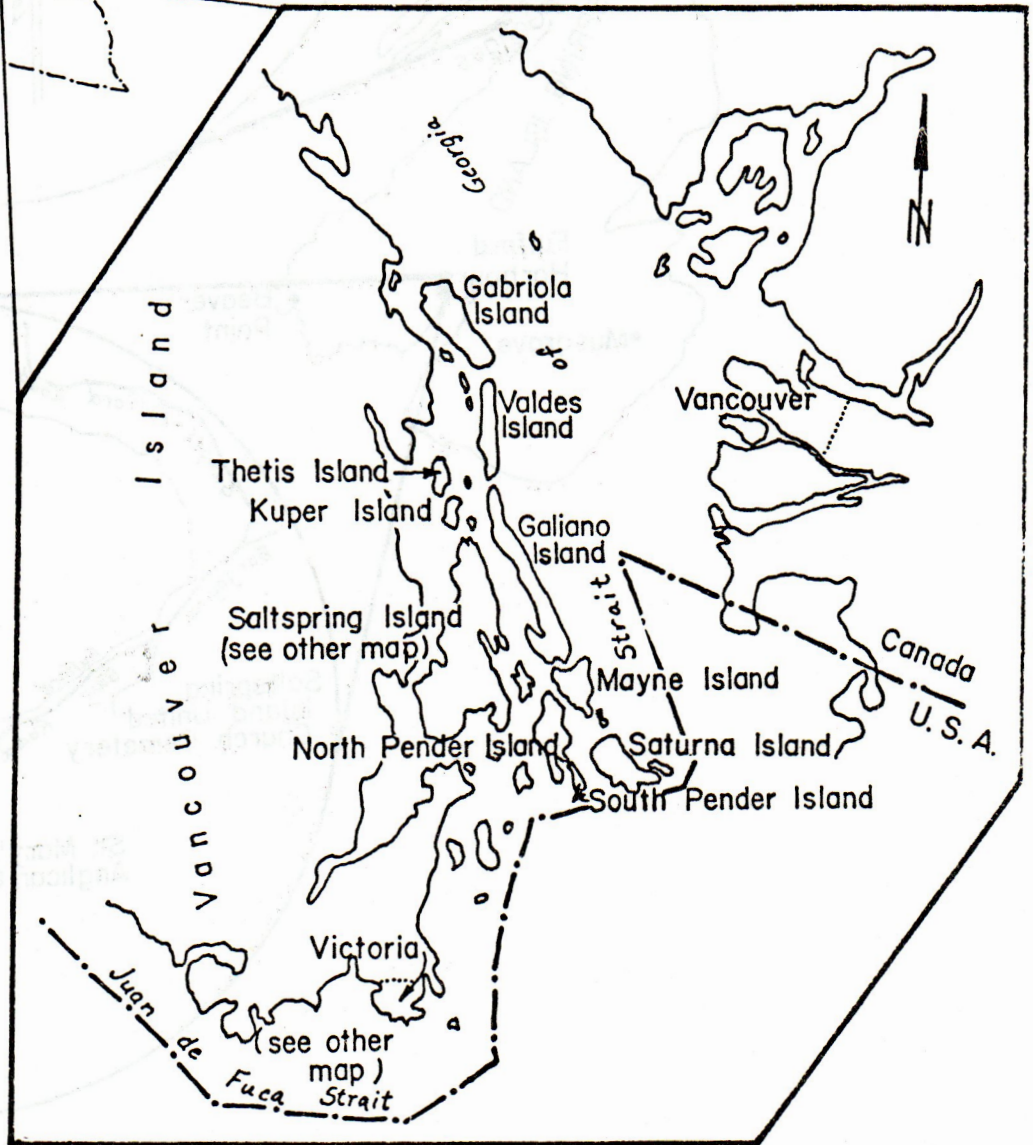
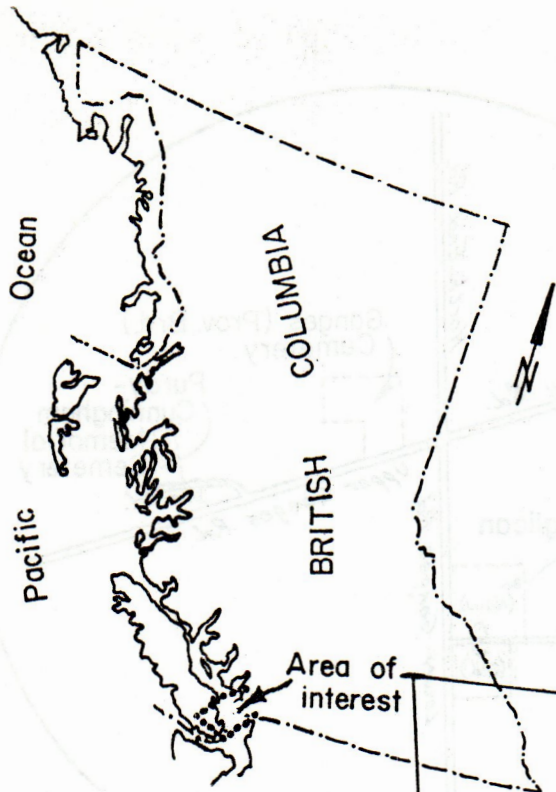

ST. MARGARET'S CEMETERY

THETIS ISLAND, B. C.

Take the Ferry from Chemainus, B.C. to Preedy Cove, Thetis Island. Following the main road. Turn left at North Cove road, go on past the school, on the left side of the road, keep on to Forbes Rd. Turn, go past a brown house on the left (Thompson's). There is a snake fence along the road. Take the dirt road where the fence breaks. This takes you to the little cemetery in the woods. It is old and needs to be cared for. The people at Thetis hope to have a sign on St.Margaret;s Rd. " To Cemetery ".

There are no records to this little cemetery, Mrs. J. Ateah is related to most of the people buried here, and will be glad to give you any information the recorder may have missed.

Mr. Arthur Dearman Janson, was the first person buried here in 1919. He was a friend of the owner of the property, Mr. Henry Burchell. The cemetery was consecrated in 1922 and then donated to the people of Thetis Island.
