

STALLO CEMETERY, YALE, BC

Three miles east of Yale just of Highway 1 between the railway and the Fraser River is a picket fenced area approximately 25" x 35". There are only three markers in the cemetery, one large stone cross and two smaller markers.

1. A large stone cross with the following words carved:

Eayem Memorial 1938AD Erected by the Stallo Indians/ in memory of many hundreds of our forefathers buried here/ This is one of six ancient cemeteries within our five mile Native fishing grounds which we inherited from our ancestors/ Rest in peace/

- 2. In memory of our ancient grave/ hundreds of remains/ cross made in 1937/
- 3. In memory of our ancient graves/ hundreds of remains/
