

Cecil Lake is located in north east British Columbia between Taylor and the Alberta border.

Dewey Simmons had the first store and post office in Cecil Lake. Dorothea Kemp was 17 when she went to work for him. He had a heart problem and when he died in 1934 he was buried at his favorite place between 3 spruce trees. That became the cemetery, unregistered. Now his widow is buried there also. Mrs. Dewey Simons (Beatrice Lexau) donated the cemetery. Stanley Kemp bought the quarter section of land and found it wasn't legal. He had to resurvey the land and pay bills again then re-donate the cemetery. The Legion is looking after the cemetery but it is being given to the Women's Institute to take care of it. Information from sexton records, general information under notes is provided by Dorothy Smith or family, and from the BC Archives Vital Events (BCARS).

Note: Some death years vary from Date of Birth/Date of Death columns to Headstone Inscriptions column. The reason for this is unknown.
