LITTLE FORT CEMETERY, LITTLE FORT, BRITISH COLUMBIA

Little Fort is located between Barriere and Clearwater at the junction of Highways #5 (Yellowhead) and #24. It was originally established as a Hudson's Bay Fort and presently has a population of approximately 350.

GPS readings: N 51° 24' 59" W 120° 12' 45"

Little Fort Cemetery is about 0.3 km south of the Village of Little Fork. From Little Fork, the road to the cemetery is the first right (orange fiber optic marker #68 is located on the south side). The road is unpaved. The distance up to the cemetery is not far, about 0.3 km, and there is an area where a car could be parked to the north of the cemetery. This parking area also is the turn around area as the road is narrow and the ditches close to the road.

The cemetery is fenced with a gate into the parking area. There are trees scattered in the area and about 30 markers and many unmarked graves. In general, there are weeds and mosquitoes although the cemetery is tidied annually by local people. Wear long pants and good shoes for this cemetery.
