Our Library is maintained by BCGS members and volunteers. It is dedicated to Walter Draycott, an early member and benefactor. The library collection includes more than 18,000 publications that enhance research and the preservation of British Columbia and Canadian genealogical heritage.

Our library catalogue is available on Library computers or online at bcgs.ca. The library is a designated FamilySearch affiliate, which means that BCGS members and guests have access to newly digitized original records that are not available for viewing at home.

Library duty volunteers cannot do research, but are available to assist.


LIBRARY HOURS:
