
To the dedication of Beverly and Phyllis Sherman and the hours spent on producing this publication for the British Columbia Genealogical Society.

NARAMATA, B.C. CEMETERY INSCRIPTIONS

Naramata is an agricultural community situated about ten miles north of Penticton, B.C. on the east side of Lake Okanagan To learn more of its early beginnings and development, suggested reading is "Naramata in Retrospect". The tree-fruit orchards and vineyards are situated on benchland several hundred feet above the lake whereas the village is at lake level. It can be reached by turning left from the upper bench road onto Robinson Avenue.

The cemetery is located on the west side of Bartlet Road which runs southward from Robinson Ave. It is administered by the Naramata Irrigation District. The recording was done in 1986 & 1987.

The transcriber has a personal interest in this cemetery as several of the orchardists that he worked for in the late 1930's lie there. As well, his wife was raised in the village of Naramata and they were married there in 1945.

If the reader has any questions about the families named in these records, we will try to answer them to the best of our ability and recollection.
