This is not a complete listing of all gravestones but merely a listing of some of the older gravestones.

Location: S.W. 1/2, sec. 16, Denman Island, Nanaimo District (1/2 acre).

The land was originally owned by the Piercy family. The first burial was in 1895.

Some early burials took place behind the United Church (in woods) in 1900. Among these were the victims of the wreck of the steamer "Alpha":

The purser- BARBER
Third engineer - MURRAY
A stowaway - McKAY

Local residents shay that the graves were never marked. The area is overgrown and is now being cleared. The only signs of a cemetery are parts of a wooden fence, a granite block, and a sandstone cross, marked:
