WANETA CEMETERY, TRAIL, BC

Waneta Cemetery was registered on April 23, 1951 and is operated by a local committee. It is still open. The cemetery is not well kept up, clover and bracken are knee high in some spots and the local cows can get through the gates. The inspector of cemeteries from Victoria has visited here.

Location: Follow highway 3B east from Trail to the junction of highway 22A (to the USA). Travel 6.2 Km on highway 22A to where a sign indicates the following:

BC Hydro Seven Mile Development

Turn left and follow the paved road for 4.3 Km then turn right onto a gravel road. The cemetery is 0.6 Km along the gravel road. The cemetery has a chain link fence but no sign on the gates.
