Nelson Memorial Park Cemetery

Nelson, British Columbia



Nelson Memorial Park Cemetery is located at the top of Falls Street in the Uphill area.

The monuments were originally recorded by Henry E. and Audrey Stevenson in 1998. The information recorded included a description of the monument, the inscription, and the section within the cemetery. These records have been transcribed and indexed into CemViewer by members of the British Columbia Genealogical Society.

The CemViewer Lite program uses the following names for the various sections within the cemetery:

It is important to correctly spell the section name when searching by location in the CemViewer program. The record counts indicate the number of people buried, with grave markers, in each section when the cemetery was first recorded in 1998.

A picture is worth a thousand words. Photographs were taken or rubbings made, in 1998, of stones that had Non-English words on them. These images have been attached to the corresponding records. Colour photographs taken in 2009 provide a more recent view of the cemetery.
