## MIDWAY CEMETERY

Midway Village is situated on the No. 3 Highway in southeastern British Columbia. To find the cemetery, proceed east on the No. 3 Highway until the eastern part of Midway is on your right. On your left will be a railway track running parallel to the highway. You will see an unmarked dirt road going left off the highway and crossing the railway tracks. Follow this road for approximately .5 km uphill and you will see the cemetery to your right.

A sign posted on the cemetery fence warns "Beware of Rattlesnakes". There is evidence of rattlesnake burrows around all the tombstones. Care should be taken during warm weather!

This cemetery was recorded October 17, 1978 by way of black and white photographs taken of the last remaining tombstones in 1954, by Mrs. Grace Hawkes. All of the stones have now been destroyed by vandals. Photo is in the Kettle Valley Museum.

The cemetery was located on the cattle range hill just above Midway, B.C. to the north. At this time its exact location is difficult to pinpoint.
